The Overholts report the new Nursing School has approval to operate for 2 years and now has 16 students. Looking to expand the nursing school to the 11th grade, a down payment (\$25,000) has been made on a multi-purpose piece of property next to them. In addition to the school, the property is one the Shalom Church has been praying might become available for their use as well. Members there have made an \$858/month pledge toward the purchase. Finally, a milk-processing business on the property has the potential for vocational schooling and outreach to the farmer members of the coop using the facility. Total cost of the property is \$257,400. Another payment of \$125,000 is due mid-September.
